OUR SERVICES

Originally founded in 1953 as United Cerebral Palsy of Central Maryland by a group of parents and concerned citizens, Unified Community Connections is today a large, dynamic nonprofit organization providing thousands of hours of services and support each year to both children and adults with a wide variety of disabilities and chronic health issues throughout the state of Maryland.

Unified Community Connections' core services are Meaningful Day Services, which include Day Habilitation, Community Development Services and Employment Services; Residential Services, which include Community Living Group Homes and In-Home Support; No Boundaries Assistive Technology Center and Transportation Services.

The broad range of services that Unified Community Connections provides are tailored to meet the unique needs of each individual, helping to fulfill their hopes and dreams by connecting them to life's possibilities and supporting them in living as independently as possible. MEANINGFUL DAY SERVICES, located

throughout Maryland, offer men and women with developmental disabilities 21 years of age and older the opportunity to engage in meaningful individual and group activities.





DAY HABILITATION SERVICES focus on the development of interpersonal, social and vocational skills. Each individual has input into his/her own unique program, and family involvement is invited and encouraged.

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT SERVICES

provide individuals with opportunities to develop and maintain skills related to community membership through engagement in community-based activities that build social connections, lifelong learning, recreation and personal development.





EMPLOYMENT SERVICES provide assistance with job selection, interviewing, training and maintaining both paid and volunteer positions in the community.

RESIDENTIAL SERVICES support

individuals in leading active, productive lives as members of the community.

COMMUNITY LIVING GROUP HOMES

provide barrier-free housing, personal care assistance and life-skills training for adults with disabilities in agency-owned or leased single-family homes and apartments throughout the state. Each home is modified to ensure accessibility in order to meet individual needs. **IN-HOME SUPPORT** assists individuals who need or want support in personal care, housekeeping and case management to remain in their own homes. Support services may be requested by the individual or a family member.





NO BOUNDARIES ASSISTIVE TECHNOLOGY CENTER offers

augmentative communication assessments and personalized training for children and adults who need communication assistance. The Center also serves as an equipment lending library. Once a device has been selected for purchase, staff customize the assistive device for the unique needs of each individual.

TRANSPORTATION SERVICES utilize

a fleet of lift-equipped buses and vans to transport the individuals to Unified Community Connections' adult day habilitation centers, places of employment, medical appointments and recreational and leisure activities of the person's choice.


